

2026 PER CAPITA ASSESSMENT

THE AMOUNT OF THE PER CAPITA ASSESSMENT FOR 2026 IS \$46.63. THIS IS THE AMOUNT THAT NEWCOMB PAYS TO THE PRESBYTERY OF EAST IOWA FOR EACH MEMBER ON IT'S MEMBERSHIP ROLLS AS OF 12/31/24. SINCE WE HAD 91 MEMBERS ON THAT DATE , WE WILL BE PAYING \$4,243.33 IN EARLY 2026. OVER THE YEARS WE HAVE HAD SEVERAL MEMBERS PAY THEIR PER CAPITA ASSESSMENT TO NEWCOMB IN ORDER TO REDUCE THE IMPACT OF THIS PAYMENT ON OUR BUDGET. IF YOU HAVENT DONE SO IN THE PAST, PLEASE CONSIDER DOING SUCH IN 2026. IN FACT, HOW ABOUT DOING A "PLUS ONE" BY PAYING FOR ANOTHER MEMBER'S PER CAPITA? MARK YOUR CHECK "PER CAPITA" OR MEMBERS USING GIVING ENVELOPES CAN PUT THE PAYMENT IN THE BLUE ENVELOPE LOCATED IN THE FRONT OF THE ENVELOPE BOX. INCIDENTALLY, THE \$46.63 IS SPLIT BETWEEN THE EAST IOWA PRESBYTERY (\$29.87), THE SYNOD OF LAKES AND PRAIRIES (\$5.50) AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY (\$11.26).


